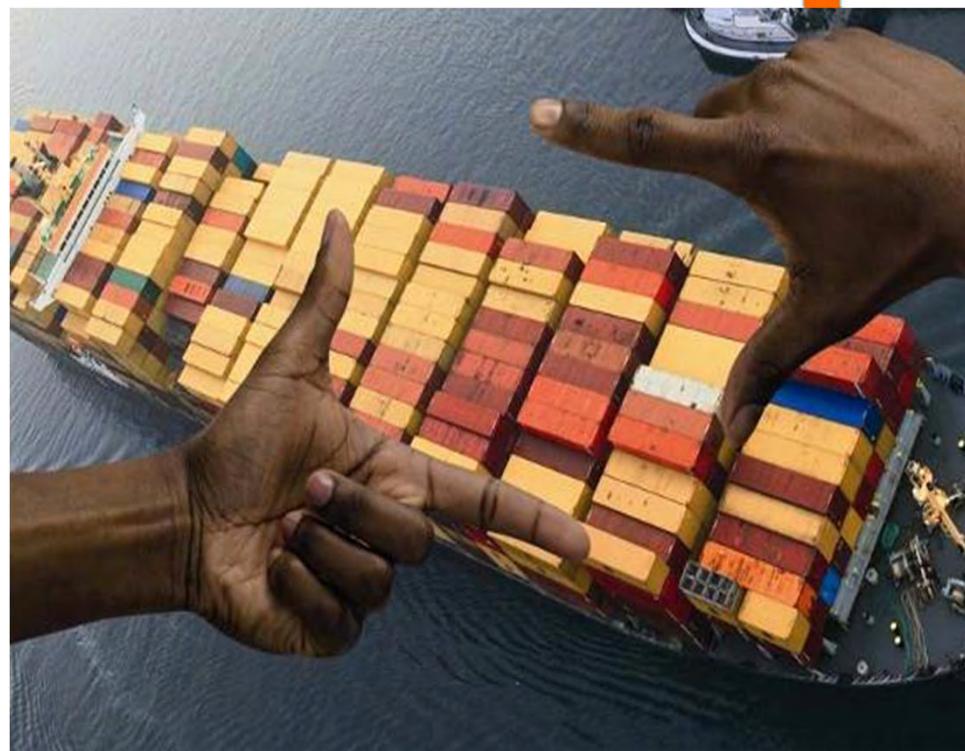


Single Electronic Window Contribution for Improvement of Trade Environment in Mozambique

MCNet, MOZAMBIQUE PROFILE

Mozambique Community Network (MCNet) is a PPP mandated by the Govt of Mozambique to implement, operate and ensure sustainability of a Single Electronic Window programme for Trade.



The objective is to:

- Provide a centralized electronic platform for trade;
- Reduce clearance times at port and airports;
- Increase revenue and;
- Generally reduce the cost of doing business in Mozambique.

Contribution For Improvement of Business Environment

MCNet in partnership with SGS, is building a SeW system that aggregates, optimises, orchestrates and secures supply chain business processes for the trading community;

This SeW will:

- Eliminate inefficient manual processes;
- Enable the provision of advance electronic cargo information on cargo and container shipments for more effective and timely clearance;



- Provide the traceability of all the supply chain;
- Provides real time tracking of all customs operations;
- Insure the implementation of administrative and customs procedures;
- Centralizes and consolidates all the supply chain information;
- Compares expected data with real data and reveals discrepancies;
- Insure secure information about customs clearance process for each and any consignment;



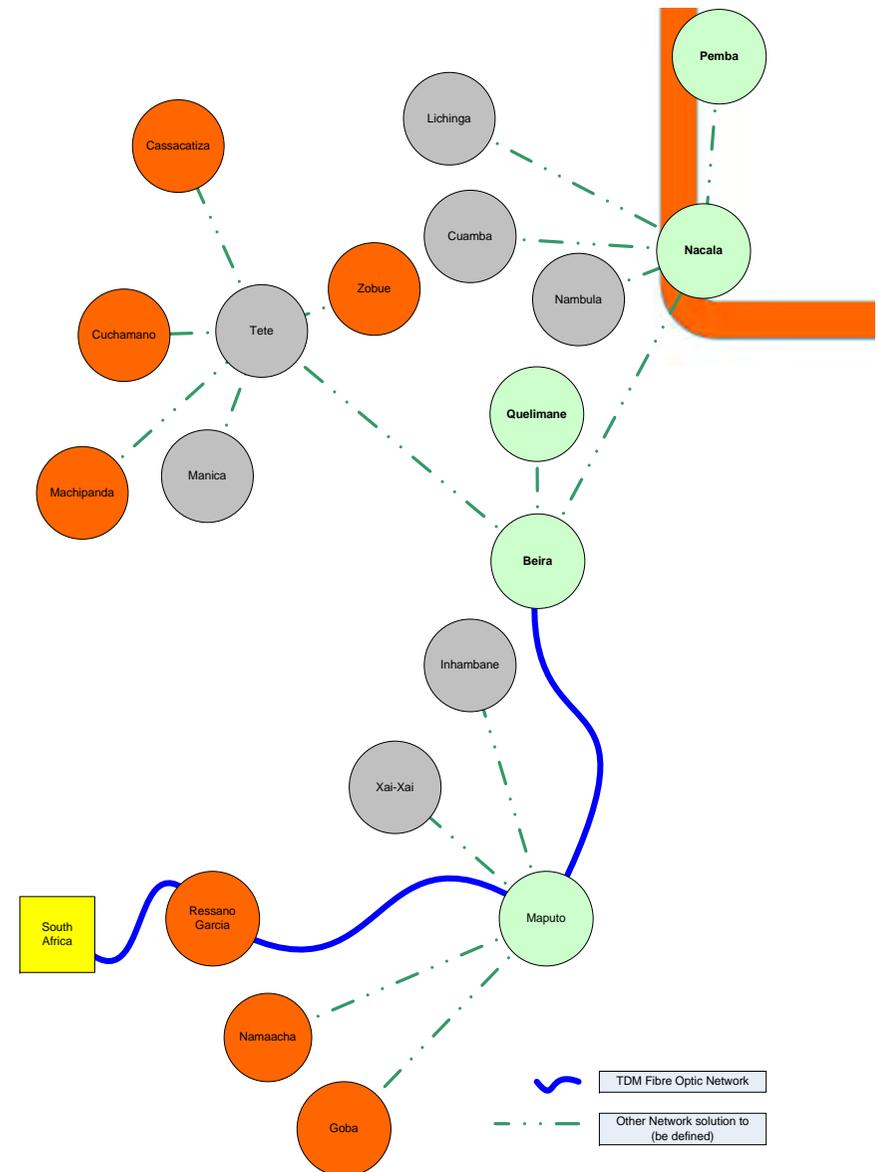
What will be delivered

- TradeNet Electronic Platform and Customs Management System;
- Data centre and offices required to run electronic systems;
- Backup and Disaster Recovery sites;
- Full private network to interconnect trade operators;
- Infrastructure for Customs nationwide;
- Call centre for offsite support, teams for onsite support;
- Training and capacity building;
- Legal reform;
- Operations and sustainability;

Functionalities to be expected

- Vessel announcements;
- Manifest management (submission, validation, distribution, amendments, supplementary, etc...);
- Declarations (submission, validation and distribution);
- Payments at commercial banks and online;
- Customs processing (Documentary review, examination, release, offence management, auctions, etc);
- Interface with Container terminal, scanner operator and other similar operators;
- Interface with Controlling Agencies and other Government Entities;
- Special regimes such as transit, warehousing, other suspense regimes.

- Private Network dedicated to the trading community (Customs, Customs brokers, Shipping Lines, Airlines, freight stations, Government Agencies etc)
- Implementation of Local, Metropolitan and Wide area Networks
- Network infrastructure fully managed and operated by MCNet
- Recognition that reliability is key to ensuring success
- Specific focus on insuring remote areas are reliably covered
- Phase 2, connectivity with neighbouring countries and specifically with South Africa



CONCLUSION

- In summary it expected that the business environment in Mozambique dramatically change with the implementation of electronic single window
- The public sector reforms in progress shows that Mozambique government is firmly committed to establish in the country a business friendly environment conducive to FDI.
